Haitong International Successfully Completed an IPO Deal for S.A.I. Leisure

Hong Kong, 16 May 2019 – Haitong International Securities Group Limited (“Haitong International”; 665.HK) has completed an IPO deal in Hong Kong for S.A.I. Leisure Group Company Limited. (“S.A.I. Leisure”; 1832.HK), for which its corporate finance team and global capital market team acted as Joint Bookrunner and Joint Lead Manager.

S.A.I. Leisure is a leisure tourism group in the tropical islands of Saipan and Guam, the U.S. territories located in the Western Pacific Region. In 2017, S.A.I. Leisure held a 33.7% market share in terms of revenue and 24.5% in terms of number of rooms sold in Saipan’s hotels and resorts industry, and was the No.1 market player by revenue, number of properties and number of rooms sold, according to Frost & Sullivan.

Haitong International has completed 14 IPOs in Hong Kong and 18 equity financing deals globally so far this year.
